In war with the Viet Cong thousands of miles away, in the middle of the cold war with the Soviet Union, and a divided nation collapsing within itself. This is what John F. Kennedy was facing when he was sworn in on the 20th of January, 1961. The nation desperately needed strong and effective leadership, all while preserving the values and beliefs of the Nation. JFK knew that this was true, so he designed his inaugural speech, that he managed to unify the nation together with common goals and values, then tell what problems and dangers the nation must face, and finally inspire the people to defend freedom and freedom. JFK's speech was very effective in fulfilling its purpose because it had the known qualities of an effective speech. For the structure of his speech, he had the great qualities of having a central goal for the speech, he supported his main points with great examples and JFK's speech was to unify the nation in order to face its future challenges. In the speech, JFK affirms its central idea at the beginning of the third paragraph. First, unite the nation by saying, Let the word go forth from this time and place, to friend and foe, that the torch has been passed to a new generation of Americans, and this declaration unites the nation after a hard election by uniting both sides of the political fence. He then proceeds to outline the second part of the central idea that the united nation is experiencing difficult times and must preserve its American values as he declares, Born in this century, tempered by war, disciplined by a harsh and bitter peace, proud of our ancient heritage, and They want to witness or allow the slow erosion of the human rights to which this nation has always been committed, and to which we are committed today at home and around the world. It's this line, he In the 1960 campaign, John F. Kennedy pledged "to get this country moving again" and offered voters a new generation of leadership. He is 160; he challenged his fellow citizens to join him in the struggle for freedom in the dangerous years of the Cold War. On the day of the inauguration, January 20, 1961, almost a million people in the nation's capital braved the freezing temperatures to catch a glimpse of the new President they had elected. The tough issues of the day... the communist threat, a nuclear arms race, racial unrest and economic problems... awaited the president and the nation. Taking office in the middle of the Cold War, JFK understood that his inaugural speech should instill confidence at home and abroad. He believed that democracy thrives only when people contribute to the common good and that it is up to leaders to inspire people to make sacrifices. And when he urged people to "ask not what your country can do for you", he appealed to the noblest instinct, expressing a message that Americans were eager to hear. Kennedy's inaugural speech reflected his beliefs and life experience. He was a war veteran; a war hero. He had read the great speeches of the ages and believed in the power of words. He thought that a democracy only thrives when people contribute to the common good and that it is up to leaders to inspire people to make sacrifices. And when he urged Americans not to ask, what your country can do for you, he appealed to their noblest instincts, expressing a message that Americans were eager to hear. He lifted the spirits of his listeners, even as he faced the sad reality of the nuclear age. The speech was a feeling. On January 20, 1961, John F. Kennedy was sworn in as the President of the United States. His short, fourteen inaugural speech minutes is better remembered for a single line to: "My American fellow citizens: Don't ask what your country can do for you; ask what you can do for your country." This call to the public service resounded with what JFK called the "new generation of Americans" born in this century, tempted by the war, disciplined by a harsh and bitter peace, proud of our ancient heritage. Virtually the only part of the speech to address domestic issues and initiatives and emotional appeals: now the trumpet evokes us again "not as a call to bring the weapons, even if the weapons we need "not as a call to the battle, even if we are born, we are "but one Call to bear the weight of a long twilight fight, year after year out, "real in hope, patient in tribulation" "a fight against the common enemies of man: tyranny, poverty, disease and war itself. Because man holds the power to abolish all the forms of human poverty in his deadly hands and all forms of human life. Yet the same revolutionary beliefs for which our ancestors have fought are still questioning all over the world "the conviction that human rights do not come from the generosity of the state but from the hand of God. We do not dare forget today that we are there heirs of that first Let the Word go ahead from this time and place, to friend and enemy in the same way, that the torch has passed to a new generation of Americans - born in this century, tempted by the war, war, With a hard and bitter peace, proud of our ancient heritage, and not wanting to testify or allow the slow dismantling of those human rights to which this nation has always been committed, and to which we are engaged today at home and around the world. That every nation knows, that we want well or badly, we will pay any price, we will bear any burden, we will address any difficulties, we support any friend, we oppose any enemy to ensure the survival and success of freedom. This is long we commit ourselves - and more ... to those nations that our opponent would have made, we do not offer a commitment but a request: that both parties begin again the search for peace, before the obscure powers of the Destruction triggered by science swallow all humanity in planned or accidental self-destruction. We do not dare to try weakly. For the mere fact that our arms are sufficient, beyond any doubt, we can be sure that they will never be used. But nor two large and powerful groups of nations can draw comfort from our current course "both sides overloaded by the cost of modern weapons, both rightly alarmed by the constant diffusion of the deadly atom, but both that runs to alter that quell "uncertain balance of terror that remains the hand of the humanity's final war. So we start again, remembering from both sides that civilization is not a sign of weakness, and sincerity is always subject to evidence. We never negotiate for fear. But we never fear of negotiating. . . . Now the trumpet evokes us again "not as a call to endure the weapons, even if the weapons we need "not as a call to the battle, even if embassy we are "but a call to endure the Weight of a long twilight fight, year in and year out, "to hope in hope, patient in tribulation" "a fight against common enemies tyranny, poverty, disease and war itself. . . . in the long history of the world, only a few generations have had the role of defending freedom in its hour of greatest peril. And so, my fellow Americans: do not ask what your country can do for you; ask what you can do for your country. My fellow citizens of the world: Do not ask what America will do for you, but what together we can do for the freedom of man....what we can do for the freedom of man.
