Confirm the positive and negative battery terminals are oriented correctly. Slide the battery chamber lock to the close position 5. The clock and calendar are set in section 3 of the setup menu p. 18. When the camera is on, the batterycondition indicator appears on the monitor. If the monitor is blank, the batteries may be exhausted or installed incorrectly. This indicator is displayed for three seconds on the monitor when the camera is turned on. Press the shutterrelease button all the way down to take the picture. Hold the camera steadily when the sunset subject program is selected as exposures can be long. Simply turn the exposure mode dial to select the appropriate subject program; the active subject program is displayed in the bottom left corner of the monitor Most portraits look best at a telephoto setting; the longer focal length does not exaggerate facial features and the shallower depth of field softens the background. Use the builtin flash with strong direct sunlight or backlight to reduce harsh shadows. The AF system continuously focuses; see page 25. When using flash, the subject must be within the flash range p. 27. A monopod is more flexible and compact than a tripod when shooting events. Used with bright outdoor scenery. When the sun is above the horizon, do not point the camera toward the sun for prolonged periods of time. The intensity of the sun could damage the CCD. Between exposures, turn off the camera or cover the lens. The use of a tripod is recommended. When used with flash, the subject and background exposures are balanced. The flash can only be used with close subjects such as with a portrait of a person. When using the flash, ask your subjects not to move after the burst; the shutter will still be open for the background exposure. This section covers the basic operations in both modes.
