He took to it WAY better than I could have ever imagined. He has been on a very steep learning curve, I was floored.

If anything, the game is too fun, for its a tad bit difficult to get him off the game. Since it has two player mode, I help him with the difficult missions. For example the car missions require way too much dexterity. He loves it when daddy helps, so works out fine. He can also play campaign mode, but again any car missions are too hard for him. My guess is a 5 year old could handle them. In Campaign mode, if you fail many times, the game actually MODIFIES ITSELF and make it easier to finish. For example, in the train robbery mission, if you fail to jump over broken track too many times, boards appear to fill in the holes. From what I can tell most areas of the campaign do this. So even areas that look way too hard do become possible for him. I am a PC gamer, I own PS3, XBOX 360, WII, and have a MAME cabinet sitting in my den. I rarely play any consoles, pretty much play PC games. This game was a pleasant surprise, and it may draw me into the console world. For First person shooter type game, bar none the best on xbox for kids under age 10 that I have seen. There are levels in it that I have a hard time completing, so its not too easy. Then there is the vaunted Toy Box mode. This is essentially a sanbox game where you can complete missions for townfolks, purchase upgrades to your town in the form of buildings or paint or many other things, or just ride around looking for things. The graphics and sounds are top notch as youll be treated to the music from the movies and although the voice work is not by the original actors, it is very good. The only negative Ive found is that if your kids cant read very well they will struggle to

complete missions because once you accept a mission and ride off to complete it, you may need to go back and read the objectives to remind yourself what you were supposed to do. If a child can't read very well, he may need some help with this. All in all, my kids enjoy the game a lot! So far, this is the best game we have found. They LOVE it. Like I said earlier, this game is not great for adults, but it is for a young gamer. Other games we have tried Lego Starwars, Lego Avengers, and Skylanders Swapwhatever. This is the easiest of all of these games, next easiest would be the Skylanders. We tried the Cars video game but the kids found it too difficult. You almost think you're playing the movie. My son was thrilled beyond measure to be able to play as Buzz Lightyear. He's four, but has mastered the Lego games, so I figured this one would be a good match after reading the reviews. I was wrong for two reasons 1. This game is VERY difficult for casual or young gamers. I'm an avid gamer and I found myself playing sections of the game over and over myself just to get him to the next level.

I don't know why on earth they didn't at least have a mode that was easy for young gamers. 2. This is the worst part My son keeps saving over his saved game. I don't know how or why, but when you go back and play level one which kids love to do as they jump around, it saves OVER all the progress you've made. Also, if a friend comes over to join, you could easily lose all the progress you've made. That means not only the levels you've unlocked, but also all the cards you've found. This never happens to us in any other Xbox game. VERY lazy programming for a kid's game especially one of this overall quality. That said, if your child is an early teen, they'll probably enjoy this for a few days anyway, but it'll be too easy for them once they get the knack.
