Washing your filter will allow the soap to seep into the pores and this cannot be removed, making the filter unusable and unsafe for your pet. The filter removes bad tastes and odours to improve the taste of the water and catches hair and small particles to keep the water cleaner. Either wash it in the top rack of your dishwasher or handwash these parts. If your dishwasher runs too hot, we recommend handwashing. When handwashing, use a bottle brush, aquarium brush, soft sponge, or brushes included in the Fountain Cleaning Kit and dish soap. Please note if you have the Avalon or Pagoda fountains, the filter housing should be hand washed. It is not dishwasher safe. There may be a faceplate cover over the impeller than can be pulled up with a coin or fingernail. Wash the impeller in soapy water, removing hair and other gunk that has collected around it. A cotton swab or small toothbrush might work too, or anything that can reach all the way inside of the cavity. Fill with water. Replug in fountain. This is a new object added to their environment, so give your pet enough time to get used to the fountain at their own pace. This time frame will usually only take a few days, and it is very rare that a pet will refuse to use the product entirely. If your pet prefers to drink running water from the faucet or shower, your pet will probably get used to the fountain very quickly. This way your pet can get used to drinking from the fountain without the noise and splash of running water. Try setting it to a lower flow setting. Remove the filter from the fountain, then add tuna juice or bouillon to the water until your pet is used to the new product. After that, you can clean the fountain, replace the filter, and refill the fountain with regular water. They are safe to use with your pets drinking water. Change them every 24 weeks, depending on how many pets use the fountain, to keep the fountain water fresh and clean. Over time, debris gets stuck in the outer fabric of the filter, making it more difficult for the water to pass through it. The inner part of the filter contains granulated carbon with hundreds or thousands of microscopic holes, which bind to impurities in the water that cause bad tastes and smells. This binding prevents impurities them from returning to the water. Eventually, the holes become clogged and can no longer remove impurities. Change the water and clean your fountain more frequently to prevent this. Soap residue may cause the sliminess. Be sure to rinse every part thoroughly before reassembling the fountain. To remove these deposits, clean the fountain parts with a 90% water, 10% vinegar solution. Rinse all parts thoroughly afterwards. Use filtered or purified water instead of hard tap water to prevent this. Some pets are prone to spilling. Watch your pet when he drinks to see if this is the cause. If it is, you can purchase a fountain mat or other waterresistant mat to place under the fountain. Look for visible cracks in the bowl. Some fountains hum a little louder than others. It should return to normal levels within a few minutes. If the noise stops when plugged back in, its possible that some debris is caught on the impeller. Remove the pump and clean the impeller. Try rubbing a small amount of vegetable oil onto the magnetic pin with a cotton bud to lubricate the impeller. See below for full cleaning steps. Try adding plain white vinegar inside the pumps cavity without the impeller and allow it to soak for 1015 minutes. Allow the impeller to soak in a separate bowl of vinegar for the same duration of time. Clean all fountain parts in soap and water before reassembling the fountain. Gently but firmly press

If the pin has completely dislodged itself from the motor, it cannot be placed back into the motor cavity properly and the motor will have to be replaced. Call Customer Care for information on replacing your motor. Sometimes it takes a few minutes for the motor to start pumping water once its refilled or plugged in. If water doesn't flow after 5 minutes, try these troubleshooting tips To prevent this, you can purchase a cord cover from most hardware stores. You could also try securing the cord to the floor with duct tape. Lack of regular cleaning may result in the pump becoming clogged with pet hair and food debris. The pump must be cleaned every 24 weeks to ensure proper function. There may be a faceplate cover over the impeller that can be pulled up with a coin or fingernail. Wash the impeller in soapy water, removing hair and other gunk that has collected around it. A small toothbrush might work too, or anything that can reach all the way inside the cavity. Hard water will cause calcium deposits to build up in the pump's cavity, blocking the impeller from spinning. If there is evidence of hard water buildup inside the pump, try adding plain white vinegar inside the pump's cavity without the impeller and allow it to soak for 10-15 minutes. Clean all fountain parts in soap and water before reassembling the fountain. If your pet is prone to chewing, visit your local hardware store and purchase a conduit cover to protect the cord. If the pump has been in regular use for several years, it may be old and need to be replaced. The fountain parts and pump are not UL approved for outdoor use. Using the fountain outside can damage the pump. If you have used your fountain outside, the pump may need to be replaced. To prevent this, always keep your fountain water above the fill line. You can also change the foam filter. This can cause the pump to overheat and stop functioning. When refilling the bowl, make sure to add water before turning the fountain on.

Try switching to a top with one fewer spout opening. The charcoal filter is made of organic coconut shells. Rinse the filter in cold water before placing it in the fountain to prevent this. Some filters may shed more charcoal than others due to differing consistency of charcoal in each batch of filters, so don't be surprised if some filters leave behind more charcoal dust than others. If you have more pets or notice more debris, a slimy feel, or decreased water flow in your fountain, you should clean it more often. Prefilters can usually be changed less frequently. The machine is quite and Ive had no problems so far. My cats like it with both with and without the flower attachment. Would buy again. It is definitely quiet, although this came after a few warm up spurts within the first few hours of use. If youve ever heard a cat drinking water, then youll know the sound this makes. Its that quiet. It would be nice if the glow feature had more color options, but thats just a personal opinion and in no way diminishes the quality of this product. The glow option is at least an option and can be turned off, if you so please. I also like that this particular model is mostly white, which is a nice variation to all the other garish colors the other brands offered. It looks nice in the corner of a room, and as a bonus, the blue glow is a nice touch during the night. All in all, I am happy with my purchase and would recommend this product to others. Ill be sure to post an update when Ive had the product longer to report on its longevity.

It's really big and perfect for two cats. It also have lights which is very cute. No loud noise like my old water fountain that I gifted to the garbage can because of the noise, no plastic smell. Loved this! It took him a few hours to realize it was for him to drink out of. First he tried playing with the water but soon enough he learned it was for drinking. Now he loves it! The fountain is quiet, easy to install, and looks great with the blue LED lights. Goes well with my other decor in the house and doesnt stand out. Definitely would recommend, especially for the price! Easy to read instructions led to no overflow or leaking. Filters included were easy to lock into place, hoping I can order more from the company or Amazon. Mom thinks its cute and cats love it. Consistent trickling noise now, was almost silent before. I would probably rate it a three and a half but Amazon does not allow in between. Excellent product! I had to get my cat to drink more water after he got a UTI, and my vet recommended trying a water fountain as cats love them. My cat drinks so much water now. It's also super quiet, check out the video. One thing to make sure is to change the filters regularly. I made the mistake of not doing that initially. I went to rinse out the fountain and just give it a quick wipe with tissue since it has some cat fur into it, and I noticed a pink color that's slimy pink mold that occurs on plastic like bathtubs, plastic pet bowls etc. That just made me think that I needed to wipe it down more often, but when I did it again a few weeks later, the pink tinge was back. So I opened it up and the filter was all pink and furry. So, wash the fountain properly with soap at least once a week to make sure that the bacteria does not multiply. And change the filter every month at least, more if your cat is furry. I think I'm going to have to change mine every 23 weeks. It's nonporous and possess the same characteristics of glass.

Bacteria that fall into the water can be easily removed. But it's more expensive, and noisier, which is why I'm happy with this one so far. I would recommend this product only if you are happy cleaning it regularly so you do not put your pets health in danger. The pump is super quiet and can just barely be heard when you are next to it in otherwise silence. It was a cinch to put together. Snap the top part to the bottom part and insert the flower. I had no idea that there was a blue night light that is hardly visible during the day. But, at night it is subtle and attractive. You can just barely hear some water trickling too. Its relaxing, in my opinion. I will update in a few months to comment on longevity of the pump. It seems to be solid though based on feel, appearance and other reviews. Highly recommended from me. Two of my friends have already purchased their cat and dog one of these. My cats water bowl used to get changed about every 5 days and was nasty after that length of time. Now, after 7 days, there is no visible debris, small bugs or cat hair floating around. The water is crystal clear. Super easy filter replacement. We had one of the rectangular machines, but the

pump got very loud after less than a year, and it was extremely hard to clean, with square corners and small passages. The pump also got a lot of slime in it, since it did not have a dedicated filter at the water intake. The Lotus Pet Fountain addresses all these shortcomings, with its all round design and a second filtering system around the pump, which is extremely quiet. Lighting system is an added bonus too its like a night light for me, although Im not sure the cat cares or not. Only negative I can offer is fact that extra main charcoal filters were not included, and were not available at the time we ordered. This was addressed quickly by the makers, since they sent us a 4pack of filters, at no charge, with overnight delivery.

Now I just need to find that filter listed for sale, as it is a smaller diameter than most of the filters listed for similar round water fountains. I could get a dozen filters for the price of these four. I still have the motor from the old fountain that will fit in the new fountain. I will start using it so I can save some money on filters. I do wish that the set included 2 of the foam filters that go around the pump to go with the charcoal filters. I would prefer to change the foam filter more often instead of just rinsing it out. The iPettie filters sold by hommii are an excellent value compared to the YouThink set. One thing is I cant get the inside filter around the motor. I had to cut it. Dogs love it and no more yuck in their drink bucket.

EDIT after careful use and good maintenance, this lasted less than 6 weeks. I cannot recommend this to you. They get old even when not used so you cant stock up I purchased these filters based on the recommended buy together, and they dont fit. Since the original water fountain came with 2 filters I used them first. I went to use the extra I bought and they dont fit. And the return period is expired. Now when I click on the link for the original fountain, they have changed the filters. So Im screwed. Either I buy a whole new water fountain or scour the internet for replacement filters. DONT BUY FOR A PET WATER FOUNTAIN THAT IS OWN PETS 2.3l They DONT fit!!!!!! Would have given it a 5, except they only included 1 wraparound filter in the pack and I would like to change it after using 2 of the square ones. Mine wear out at the same rate. I have a lot of extra filters. Do a good job of keeping the water clean. Very pleased. These ones are made specifically for the Lotus or Ball shape 2.1 litre fountain. They arrived quickly and they also have the right size foam filter included which fits around the fountain motor. Very satisfied. Will purchase again. Arrived as expected. Ive tried tap, filtered and bottled water. They keep turning red. I will never use these again. Garbage The first one was made of plastic. It was not easy to clean and I didnt know if the plastic is healthy for my cat. I bought a new one, made out of metal. It was easier to clean, but after a few months I noticed that the water had a metallic smell. It was also noticeable noisier compared to the plastic one. For both of these, the filters were quite expensive. I looked for a new one which is easy to clean, healthier for the cat and with less expensive filters and more silent. Thats when I found the iPettie. Here are some things the cat loves about it The middle of the fountain is upper and the water falls down.

My cat loves to drink the falling water The taste of the water is better, as the ceramic doesn't impregnate any taste. Also as the filters are less expensive, so it incentivises me to change them more often The cat can drink water even when the fountain is turned off Here is what I love about it It is easy to clean, so it saves me lots of time It is quite silent when set up correctly on an even surface Cons It comes with two pumps one spear one, after a week one of them broke. The customer support has instantly sent me another replacement pump. Water is critical to keeping your cat healthy. While cats get moisture from a raw or canned diet, they should still have plenty of fresh water available at all times. The girls watched as I took it out of the big box addressed to "Allegra and Ruby King." I think they were probably expecting to hear some colorful language from me when I saw the words "the fountain is not fully assembled" on the instructions. Thankfully, what little assembly it required was something even I could handle, and a few minutes later, it was filled with water, plugged in, and ready. You can adjust the flow of water. The pump is barely audible, and the trickle of water provides a nice background sound, especially on a hot day. The fountain features replaceable foam filters to catch cat hair and other debris and keep your cat's water clean. It is dishwasher safe, which I really like. But how did Allegra and Ruby like it. Allegra went to check it out immediately, as you can see in the video below. It took her a few hours to warm up to this new addition to our dining room. I like almost everything about this fountain. I like the sleek, simple design and unobtrusive color. I like the ease of assembly and the nearly silent operation. I love that it's mostly ceramic the bowl and the elevated water dish are. Now I give my cat Mojo Brita water out of a bowl and I always worry that he drinks enough water, especially in this heat. I think he would love it too, he loves anything that moves and loves to sit in the bathroom sink and watch the water. My cats would love it. They are always fascinated by the water coming out of the sink and drink from it. Thanks! I have 4 of the cat type and one doggy. Two of our kitties love water. Both Hitch and Punpkin play with our one fountain often. The only time Mistletoe, Tiger and Lizzie have to use it is when the waterboys are joining me in the restroom. They enjoy playing in the tub with a trickle of water while I brush my teeth and complete my morning routine. There are always bowls of fresh water out also, but the cats don't care for that. This lovely new fountain is stylish enough to put in the most public parts of the house. It would lend with any decor. I know that the length of the comment isn't part of the requirements, so I'll end here.

I'll attempt to post this on Facebook, but the iPad doesn't perform like a PC or laptop. So until I get the PC replaced I'm mobile. Thanks for the blog, I've enjoyed reading it for a little while now. I've learnt quite a bit. Thank you, Dot This beautiful fountain would keep me from having to run around all day turning on the faucets for them! Yet we never see either cat drink. Since we switched from kibble to canned, neither cat seems interested even in drinking from the tap. They both used to drink, and we are determined to find the right item to entice them back to water. This product looks stylish and quiet; just the thing for my furbabies! I'm so glad Drinkwell has finally figured out that ceramic, not plastic, is the way to go. For the last two years or so, one of my cats kept knocking the lid off so he could drink from the bubbling water so I thought this model would work and it

undeniably looked nice. What this fountain doesn't have is an easily accessible flat surface to drink from which my other cat likes. To get to the flat water, my big cat has to wedge his head between the upper bowl and side of the big one. As he is long haired with a big ruff, he came out dripping. Finally took the upper bowl off and it helped although I had to supplement it with regular bowls of water too. If I had to do it again, as this is my only fountain, I would go back to the original design. I know this probably won't put me in the running for another one but thought you'd appreciate the experience. I really like that it's mostly ceramic although I agree that the least amount of plastic used the better and I appreciate that the pump is very quiet. I would very much like to try one in the hopes that it would motivate the cats to drink even more. Thank you for the generous giveaway! I would LOVE to have one of these for Misty. She has a blast playing with dripping water from the sink, so I know she would enjoy a fountain like this.

The design is so awesome too, far better than any other fountain I've seen. If I don't win, I just might have to buy one I love pet products that blend into my home. It would be great to have an additional one to accommodate one of our shy cats who likes to live in a particular room and only rarely ventures out. My kitties have a water attraction that has them knocking over any vessel that holds any kind of liquid in the house. We can only drink our own water, coffee, or milk from travel mugs to avoid having kitty paws "dipped" into our drinking glasses. They have taken over the sink in the guest bathroom, which we reluctantly gave to them after cleaning up too many spilled water bowls and glasses to count. The sink is now filled each day with fresh kitty water and if any human in the house wants to actually use that bathroom for the purpose intended, they go elsewhere to wash their hands. We have a Drinkwell 360 that our guys enjoy — but it could be donated to someone who didn't have one if we win the Lotus. He keeps trying to drink out of the faucets, so this fountain would be great. Plus, the fountain itself is really attractive — I would keep it where everyone could see it — it's very decorative! So I would really love to win the Lotus as the ceramic is perfect! Annie has some kidney failure and goes into the tub to lick all the water droplets she can find. Sammy rarely drinks enough water and has to eat enough wet food to fulfill his water needs. As I don't have a feline companion of my own, I invited a friend having cats, Susan Whiteaker, to demo the PetSafe Drinkwell Lotus Fountain. The PetSafe Drinkwell Lotus Pet Water Fountain is made for critters up to 25 pounds, especially those that are intrigued by moving water. It has two ceramic dishes at different heights and a center cone that serves as the fountain. A small pump is nestled beneath the center cone to keep the water moving. The pump is circled by a foam filter which catches debris and pet hair as the water circulates to keep everything fresh. It holds 50 ounces of water that continuously flows upward and then falls into the top ceramic dish. The water then freeflows out three lips into the lower bowl. The fountain is mostly ceramic which is a definite plus for kitties that have acne problems from plastic bowls. The cone that carries the water from the bowl to the top of the cone is plastic as well as the tubing from the pump, but it isn't a problem because areas that a cat's chin might touch are ceramic. Some websites charged shipping while others did not. Many sites carry the fountain, but it took a bit of Googling to find the accessories other than the replacement filters. For the other kitties, I hoped this fountain would encourage drinking more water which is especially important for many kitties for

health reasons. It was a bit of a challenge figuring out where to situate the fountain where it was close enough to an outlet.

No doubt the length is for safety reasons, though, so there isn't a cord snaking across a room or running the length of a wall for kitties to chew or humans to trip. Although nothing is mentioned in the owner's manual, I do not believe that an extension cord would be a safe idea. The pump is wonderfully silent; all you hear is the trickling water. I must admit, however, that more than once I was taken aback at the sound of running water that I actually got up to investigate what I was afraid was a water leak in the bathroom. Ultimately I was disappointed because none of my cats would drink from it, regardless of whether it was running or it was unplugged. Even Laz, the Water Baby, lost interest after the first day. While the fountain was running, they avoided their regular water dishes which sat next to the fountain. The fountain ran for about a week before I gave up. It never got to the point of needing to be cleaned and the water never got cloudy or dirty, so the filter is obviously doing a good job. There are product reviews on Amazon.com where people absolutely swear by this fountain. Perhaps their kitties are braver than mine.
