Garrison 3.0 out of 5 stars The handles on the 790s steering column are wider than the 796, which means you have better leverage for steering control, and thus, better steering control. The 796 does come with a small basket, which is handy, but the Schwinn quickrelease wire basket, although a separate purchase, is bigger, and not too hard to attach. The 790s release catch to fold down the steering column is much easier to use vs. the 796. The catch release on the 790 can be a onehanded maneuver, although youll probably use the other hand to keep the steering column from just falling down once the catch is released. You slide up a spring button to release the flip lever, which has a tab that catches the latchbolt as you pull down the flip lever. The 796 catch release is a pushbutton, but the push button is so small you cant use your finger, you have to use something like the eraserend of a pencil to be able to push it in far enough to release the catch and fold it down, obviously a nuisance to try to do in the hasteofthemoment of stowing it into your vehicle.

Between that and the shorter steering handles, I think the 796 is better suited to indoor use. The only negative I found to the latching on the 790 is the latchbolt is spring loaded, and occasionally, the tab on the fliplever release could push past it, meaning you have to pull down the latchbolt by hand quicker, or flip the lever up and down trying to get it to recatch. You can most easily release

the catch by pulling the steering column towards the catch mechanism, which ensures its flush to the bottom section of the steering shaft and not putting any pressure against the latch bolt, leaving the latchbolt free to pivot down without resistance. This is handy everywhere, although especially inside within tighter quarters. The downside to this is it can be easier to get off balance with the 790 you have to be careful not to crank the steering all the way to the side of your good leg and lean over your elevated leg the other way, you can go right over. A little cautious forethought and you can avoid spilling yourself. The 790 does not have a knee pad slightly offset to one side, the 796 does have an offset knee pad. For the 796, you want to make sure the knee pad is offset towards the scoot leg, which also makes it more tipproof. Interestingly, even though made by the same company, the seat columns are different diameters and thus not interchangeable I tried, wouldnt swap. The other advantage of an offset seat is your scooting foot is over a little further and less prone to rake against the rear wheel. I didnt really have a problem with that with the 790, although its advisable to wear some sort of foot gear scooting around indoors rather than just socks or barefoot.

It got some usage on city streets, here they have these dimpled traction pads for lack of a better description on the sloped part of the sidewalk ramps; the dimples are large enough and high enough that they are difficult to traverse over with a knee walker, the dimples have the handlebars wanting to twist out of your hands no way to roll over those things quickly or easily. The 796 wheels also turn freely enough, the 796 steering column seemed to have more resistance than the 790, although that could be attributed to having less turning leverage with the shorter handlebars. The 796 has a single brake handle which actuates brakes on both rear wheels. The 790 has serrated metal pieces that press against the rear wheels for braking; the 796 uses bicyclestyle rubber brake pads that press against the rear wheels. Both models, you can lock the brakes on, and pulling the brake handle releases the springloaded brake lock. Because of the serrated metal pads and handles for each rear brake, the 790 has more stopping power for the brakes having two hands braking obviously you can apply more braking force than being able to only use one hand, as on the 796; that, plus the rubber brake pads of the 796, although a replaceable wear item, cant bite against the rear wheels as much as the metal counterparts on the 790. If the rear wheels of the 796 get wet, it would be the same loss of stopping grip as a bicycle in the rain. The serrated metal of the 790, thats not much of an issue, except it can be easier to just lock up one or both of the rear wheels thus back to keeping rolling speed within reason. In the couple months usage, I didnt discern enough usable wear on the rear wheels to be a problem seems like it would take a long time for the metal pads of the 790s brakes to wear the wheels to the point of needing replacements.

The 790 brake cables did stretch some similar to bikes over the couple months usage, but not enough that I couldnt readjust within the range of the turning adjusters further stretching would require pulling the cable tighter through the bolt clamps again, similar to bicycles. The knee pads on both models were wellcushioned and fine, just different designs. Not a flaw, I suspect most would not have this happen. The 796 is toolsfree assembly, the 790 involves some simple assembly of the steering column with a provided allen wrench the biggest challenge for the 790 is getting the handlebars parallel with the front wheels. If you push the front wheels against a straight wall, youll have more visual reference for parallel alignment. I think both were taped shut. Needing to be upstairs made keeping a 2nd on walker on the upper floor a logical choice. In any case, using it to navigate stairs is only recommended if the stairs are deep enough to rest both back wheels that, plus turning it completely and pushing the other front wheel against the step, is the only way its stable to make a secure maneuver. Dont even try it if your not sure about it, as the risk of a fall and further injury while trying to heal isnt worth it. The 790 gets 4 stars, Id say giving it an offset kneepad would about make it perfect, but its perfectly fine asis. The 796 gets 3 stars due to lackofease with the release catch for folding down the steering column, shorter handlebars, single handbrake handle, and the functional nuisance of the greater turning radius. Due to the blizzard, none of the

After rupturing my plantar fascia, my left leg was deemed useless. I summoned this pimp wagon immediately after leaving the orthopedist and paid for oneday shipping. The price was a skimpy chunk compared to the crapton amount the hospital peddlers wanted. Con This little beast arrived with ZERO instructions. Cut redneck engineering brain. Or just use your normal, not cool brain. Be ready to improvise on bolt and nut location. The first one is easy. Pro Surprisingly, this happy campin scooter can tote major ass. Weighing in a svelte 434 lbs., this is the little scooter that could. Now, Im not saying everyone cant swing in and not snap the welds, so dont sue me. Im saying that that golden, amazing little scootscoot carried me on a cloud of angel farts. I wrapped my beast in Hannah Montana stickers, sparkly streamers and a police light and siren. Get off those crutches. Get up off that couch. Get yourself a brand new scoot scoot to cart your jumbled body to and fro. Problem is a part broke off, and I sent an email on their sight filling it out per their instructions what was wrong, and describing the part, and todate I havent heard back from anyone, so the scooter ended up being useless. If you don't back your products, you wont be in business very long. It is very easy to operate. It adjusts up and down easily. It folds down with a flip of the handle to fit into the car. The only thing that I see wrong with it is not easy in the grass or other areas that arent solid floors or concrete. It says all terrain but that is not the case. It is very light weighs. Has great breaks. I must say I trust amazon choices. So I chose this one.

My husband asks me why this one. It has a gap in the middle. I said I don't know but it was rated amazons choice. 3 weeks later. I made the correct choice. I love the basket. I also purchased the plush sheepskin cover which filled in the gap. That was perfect for when I had the cast on. Now I'm in a boot, that has an adjustable air type button which isn't comfortable because it digs into my shin. Now I see why the gap in the scooter. The bottom on my boot seems to fit precisely in the gap area making it more comfortable and not allowing air button to dig into my shin. It's also adjustable. I'm 5'2 my husband 6'3. Adjusts to both our sizes. Other amazing feature no one mentions is that it has a brake button so the scooter doesn't run away on me at night. 1st night I used it I parked it next to my bed. I got comfortable and watched it roll away from me. Thank God hubby discovered button on top of brakes gets pushed in and scooter stays in place. Press the handle and brake releases. Very happy camper. I refuse to use crutches!!The nature of the break required that no crutches were to be used. This had me unable to move around for weeks. Fortunately, I discovered the knee walker and in shortorder it was delivered. The unit assembly was easy and accomplished without tools. The unit is very solid and supports weight up to 350 lbs. Its easy to use and you really feel in control. Its extremely stable. It has a tremendous range of adjustment. The tires are hard plastic; they dont mark the floor and are solid no need to add air because of low tire pressure. One feature that is positive that is often overlooked by the competition is a locking brake. I find this beneficial in getting off and on the scooter; a definite safety feature. I definitely recommend this unit. It was a game changer. It is smooth and easy to usealmost too fun to drive. I have used it after two separate surgeries on my bunions and have leant it to several people.

It is still going strong replaced brake pads once. The only criticism would be the knee pad has a gap in it for some reason that is quite uncomfortable made a pad that I strapped over top and that worked fine. It doesnt have a great turning ratio but otherwise is a great product. Crutches were working just not very well. Due to age and size I did not feel particularly safe on crutches. This knee

walker is not that maneuverable in the house but I feel very secure and that makes all the difference. I went outside and it works very well on side walks. Would be great in a mall. I feel save and secure, I could use a bell. Very sturdy and stable. I can easily rest my leg on this while I prepare meals. Can easily navigate the sharp corners in a house. Very comfortable although I do use a knee pad to equalize with the cast.My ankle was casted at an angle which made it hurt to bend my leg. However I did sell it and the person who bought it said it was wonderful.
