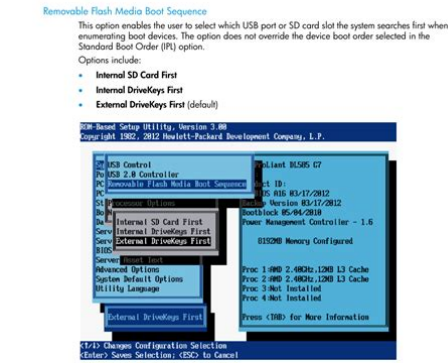

DriveKey seems to be installed correctly. I can access the DriveKey config menu. Settings are the same as those described in first post. Original discs boot fine. The Wii is a D2E with epoxy. My problem is that any disc I put in silently crashes the wii. All of these attempts cause the wii to crash shortly after inserting the disc. Personally I avoid WISCRUBBED ISOs and shady torrent sites. Even if the games they have are really good. I try to download the full ISOs even if they weight 4.6GB or more. That way you might get a chance to get it working. One last thing if your DVD burner is old or of a not very good quality try recording at 1x4x.
