Stalling on Railroad Tracks If no train is coming you can put you car in neutral and get people to help push it off the tracks but if a train is coming, get away from your car and walk towards the train but at a 45 degree angle away from the vehicle and tracks Brake Failure If your brakes suddenly fail, shift to a lower gear and pump the brake pedal fast and hard several times. If that doesnt work pull the emergency brake Tire Blowout hold the steering wheel firmly and keep the vehicle straight. Do not hit the brakes and coast to a stop. Gas Pedal Problems If the gas pedal sticks, keep your eyes on the road and shift to neutral. Steer the vehicle to a safe area and call for help. A receipt will be provided.
