Night Driving: At night, a motorist's vision is reduced. A vehicle may spin if the steering wheel is quickly turned away from the direction of the skid.

To avoid a spin, turn the direction the rear of a vehicle is skidding, without oversteering. Emergency Stops: With paved shoulders, signal and turn onto the shoulder at or near traffic speed, then begin to slow down. With unpaved shoulders, signal a turn and then slow down to a safe speed before turning off. Running off the pavement: Slow down, regain control, turn slowly onto the road. Car fires: Do not waste time, get out of the car, never attempt to put out the fire. Plunging into Water: Open window and escape if vehicle is still floating. Easiest to open a door when completely underwater. Stalling on Railroad Tracks: If no train is coming, you can put your car in neutral and get people to help push it off the tracks, but if a train is coming, get away from your car and walk towards the train but at a 45 degree angle away from the vehicle and tracks. Brake Failure: If your brakes suddenly fail, shift to a lower gear and pump the brake pedal fast and hard several times. If that doesn't work, pull the emergency brake. Tire Blowout: Hold the steering wheel firmly and keep the vehicle straight. Do not hit the brakes and coast to a stop. Gas Pedal Problems: If the gas pedal sticks, keep your eyes on the road and shift to neutral. Steer the vehicle to a safe area and call for help. A receipt will be provided. It should be kept in a safe place. However, you shouldn't rush it. Before retaking the NJ permit test, make sure that you study thoroughly before trying again. If you fail the test three times, you will have to wait 6 months before you are able to try again. During that time, you should practice driving with a licensed driver, who is 21 years old or older, accompanying you and sitting in the vehicle next to you. If you are 16 years old, you also need to attend a complete Driving School course. Once the 6 months waiting period is over and you are at least 17, you may apply for your provisional license. You must answer at least 40 questions correctly in order to pass i.e.

The Adult Road is an approach for those individuals who are 21 years of age or older who are working to obtain their basic driver's license. This is a three phase process, much like the Early Bird Option and Young Adult Road for younger drivers. Here we will outline the Adult Road license process as presented by the NJ Motor Vehicle Commission. To receive the examination permit, the applicant must appear at a Motor Vehicle Commission or MVC agency and present six points of identification. The applicant must then pass the knowledge and vision test and pay any applicable fees. In order to complete this task successfully, the applicant must observe the following restrictions the applicant must be accompanied by an adult 21 years old or older who has had their license for a minimum of three years, seat belts are required to be worn at all times, and cell phone use is prohibited. Unlike the two previous options, there are no restrictions on the number of passengers allowed in the vehicle. On successful completion of this test, the applicant will receive his or her probationary license. This license is effective for one year and comes with the following restrictions cell phone use is prohibited and seat belts must be worn by the applicant and all passengers. After

the probationary license period of one year has passed, the applicant will return to the Motor Vehicle Commission agency in order to receive his or her basic driver's license.
