It can also be used to arm and disarm any partition. Many people will only use the master code on their system. To change it you must have access to programming mode. The system should beep 3 times and exit back out. Most DSC systems use the same procedure. Our step by step guide below will walk you through chaining the master code. User Location 40 is for the Master Code on the DSC 1616 and cannot be deleted but it can be changed to a new code. Now you can proceed to testing the code. Austin, TX 78734. Local 5128003030. Toll Free 8669456257. Fax 8779556257. If you just bought or defaulted your PowerSeries panel, the codes will be at these defaults. If you are taking a system over, there is a high probability that the codes will be changed. But it is always a good idea to at least try these codes first as it is not unheard of for the installer code to be left on the default. The master code is automatically assigned to user number 40. The master code is the first user code that comes programmed on the panel and it cannot be deleted, but it can and should be changed. The master code allows you to do quite a few things on the alarm system. You can arm and disarm the system and any partition on the system if you are using multiple partitions. You will want to change this to a code that only you know so that someone does not break in and just try to enter 1234 to disarm the system. This would make your alarm system much less effective against a break in. The installer code is the code that is used to get into the DSC programming mode so you can set the system up and make changes to panel programming. Having the installer code is the most important part of setting up the system. You will not be able to arm or disarm with the system with the installer code. The installer code, like the master code should ideally be changed to a number that is not easy to guess. While it is perhaps not as critical as changing the master code for security purposes, if someone has access to the system while it is disarmed and they have intentions to make changes having an installer code that is not the system default is important. This is applicable if you use your system at home or for your business or commercial security alarm system. You may need to add or remove users access codes on the keypad on your system from timetotime as people are hired into your business, as keyholders change, due to changes to cleaning or maintenance staff or many other reasons. How To Test Your Alarm System Locally If you would like to verify that your Power, battery and siren are fully functioning, you can perform a local system test in the user menu section of your alarm system. The panel will perform the following; activate the Siren, keypad buzzer and all keypad status lights for 2 seconds, test the backup battery and transmit a reporting code to the central station. How To Program Time and Date To Program Time and Date you will have to enter the user menu section of your alarm system. Below is a detailed list of all possible troubles on your system. If light 1 stays on, it indicates you have a low battery condition, and need to replace your system

If another number shows on your keypad, please contact Safetech Technical Support. You can check that the transformer has not been unplugged, or that any service is being done to the power in your area. If the problem persists, contact technical support for further assistance. If this trouble is present, make sure you have a dial tone on your phone line, ensure that your phone company is not working on the phone lines, as well as making sure no other devices are tying up the line like a fax machine, or DSL modem. The system will attempt a number of times to send a signal, after all attempts have failed to reach the central station, it will display this trouble. Once you know which zone number is in trouble, check that the physical contact has not been tampered with for the particular zone, if everything appears to be normal, contact SafeTech technical support. Once you have verified the zone, check to see if the contact has been physically tampered with, if everything appears normal, contact SafeTech technical support for further assistance.

How to Disarm Your Alarm System The user must enter through a door programmed as Delay. Upon entering, the keypad will emit a steady tone, and emit a pulsing tone during the last 10 seconds of entry delay to alert the user to disarm the system. Enter a valid user code to disarm the system.

How To Arm Your Alarm System

Away Arming The Ready light must be ON to arm the system. If the Ready light is OFF, ensure all protected doors and windows are secure or bypassed. To arm the system in the Away mode, either press and hold the Away function button for 2 seconds or enter a valid user code and leave the premises through a door programmed with entry delay. Upon arming, the Armed light will turn ON. If the Audible Exit Delay option is enabled, the keypad will beep once every second during the exit delay, and three times a second during the last 10 seconds to alert the user to leave.

Stay Arming The Ready light must be ON to arm the system. If the Ready light is OFF ensure all protected doors and windows are secure or bypassed. To arm the system in the Stay mode, either press and hold the Stay function button for 2 seconds or enter a valid user code and stay within the premises do NOT violate a door programmed as Delay. Upon arming, the Armed light and Bypass light will turn ON. If the Stay function button is used, the keypad will not beep during the exit delay. If a user code was used, the keypad will beep if the Audible Exit Delay option is enabled.

How To Program A User Code LED Keypad. The Program light will flash. The keypad will turn ON the corresponding zone light to indicate a user code is programmed. Enter the 2digit user to be programmed. The zone light will flash. The Program light will flash. Enter 40 and the new 4 digit master code. The Program light will flash. Scroll to the user you would like to delete, or enter the 2 digit user number. The Bypass light will flash. The keypad will turn ON the corresponding zone light to indicate a zone is bypassed. To bypass or unbypass a zone, enter the 2digit zone number. The Bypass light will be ON if any zones are manually bypassed. If the Code Required for Bypass option is enabled, enter a valid user code.

DSC highly recommend changing your master code to something harder to guess to reduce the chance of an intruder being able to override the alarm system. You might also want to change the master code if you suspect it is known by someone outside your family or business. Enter the current master code using the number buttons. The code must be four digits long unless your system was programmed differently by the installer. Only use numbers 1 through 9 in your code. The new master code is now ready to use. Default Installer code 1500. Default Once this command is entered,

the keypad buzzer will beep several times. The trouble LED will be on during the reset sequence. In LOCATION 12 toggling 5 on will set the zones for normally closed loops. Toggling 5 off will set the zones for end of line resistors. LOCATION 11 has slots for zones 16. As you programme each 2digit zone type, it will jump to the next zone. When you finish all 6 zones, it will leave the location. The zone type will determine how the zone will work. Once you have selected a user, enter the new 4digit code number you wish to add. This will get you into user programming mode. If that doesn't work you can recover or reset it from installer programming. Once in programming mode, go to Location 21 and either enter your new master code or use the right arrow to read out the current code. If you can't get into programming mode, you will have to default the panel. It's looking for a 4digit entry. If your account number has hex digits ABCDEF you will have to change to hex programming. If your account number has a zero in it, it must be programmed as an A. Leaving the programming location also turns off hex mode. You will need to input the correct reporting codes, depending on the format you choose. Enter 00 or FF to disable reporting for that section. The keypads will also beep twice every 10 seconds until the fault has been acknowledged. It will stay activated until a successful communication has been made.

Ready light must be on. The trouble light will light up when there is a system fault present. The keypads will also beep twice every 10 seconds until the fault has been acknowledged. Disarm To disarm when in STAY mode. From Security Screen, press "SECURITY", "DISARM", Enter code. To disarm when in AWAY mode, Enter code. Select code to change. If a zone is bypassed in error, press that zone number again and the zone light will go OFF indicating that the zone is not bypassed. If an access code already exists, it will be replaced by the new code. Most panels use 2digit zone numbers. Large Vista 100 and Vista 128 panels use 3digit zone numbers. The panel will bypass zones that are open. Most panels require a 2digit user number. A few panels have 1digit user numbers. Try a 2digit user number first. If that doesn't work, use a 1digit number.
