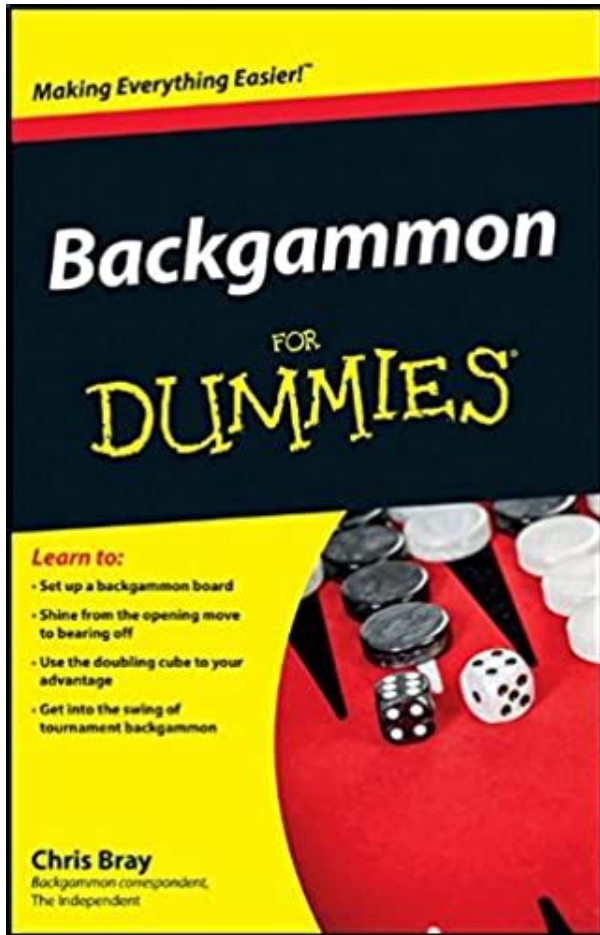


I also tested it over night by sleeping in a different room and by taking it outside. It was possible to hear every gurgle, cough, or cry from my babies. With the volume turned up, the sound was loud and clear, and it was like having the babies in the same room. Some nights, we had a fan blowing and the sound was very faint. You can set it to beep, display only or no alert at all. It is handy to have it muted and the beep setting switched on to alert you of crying if you wanted to watch a movie and have the lullabies on. I did however notice that it would beep when some of the lullabies were playing. The monitor has a 300m outdoor range and a 50m indoor range. I tested it outdoors by taking it to the bins that are approximately 200m away from our flat. It lost connection briefly as I was turning the corner but it beeped to alert me of this. There are 2 identical chargers in the box, one for the parent unit, and one for the baby unit. This means that you don't have to worry about mixing them up. The parent unit has chargeable batteries, which are conveniently already in place straight from the box, however they do require charging for 16 hours prior to use. With a little bit of fiddling around, it is really easy to get to grips with all of the functions on the monitor. It's definitely worth a read anyway, just to make sure you are familiar with all of the features available. I really liked this feature on the monitor as our twins love music and have always required some noise to soothe them. The womb noise, which is a particular favourite for the twins, was a little on the quiet side though. However, it isn't very bright and in order to fully visualise the projection, the room has to be in complete darkness. Luckily we have a blackout blind and the twins like darkness at night to fall asleep. I assessed the accuracy of the temperature display by comparing it against two other thermometers Gro Egg and Dimplex. Unfortunately my two both need to see my face to soothe them and voice alone is just not enough, but if you have a baby that just likes to hear that you are near then this feature is great! It doesn't have a stop watch function though, so you can only set the timer to remind you to feed or limit how long each feed lasts. Both the parent and baby units are really small and lightweight. There is no need to mount it to the wall and the chargers have long cables that can reach sockets and tables. The parent unit can easily fit in most pockets too. This monitor has fantastic sound with great clarity and is reasonably priced. I also really like the songs and the projection but if you aren't bothered about the additional features then BT have a simpler version of the monitor for 24.99. I actually found that I was using this monitor as our main monitor and our Philips Avent smart one just to take a quick peek if they were crying before tending to them. Do they last as long as advertised The monitor will alert you once they start running low. Is the unit rechargeable. Does it charge quickly There are 3 bars that decrease as the battery decreases. Once the battery is reaching the punt that it will require charging, the monitor will beep to alert you and the battery icon flashes. The parent unit can still be used while it is charging and unlike previous models, there is no docking station. The charger simply plugs into the back of the free standing unit. The parent is rechargeable, but the baby unit isn't. The parent unit charges within 16 hours if switched off and 24 hours if it is being used. The additional features are fun and can help them drift off to sleep, however the projection needs to be brighter and some of the songs could be louder. To learn more about how we use the cookies, please see our. The question becomes how extensive you want those tabs to be, as the range of things that can be monitored keeps expanding. At first you might be with your newborn all the time, so have no need for a monitor. At some point you find yourself out of easy earshot of your baby, chatting with friends or watching a film, and you realise that a monitor would be a useful thing to have. An audio monitor does the trick, you think, as all you need to know is whether or not your baby is awake and crying. Is your baby rubbing their eyes and likely to fall asleep again at any moment. Or is your baby crying because they're uncomfortable and need rescuing. Now that you've started to consider video cameras, you find yourself asking is a static camera good enough. Or follow them around the room once they're old enough to climb out of the cot. On top of choosing between audio and video, some monitors incorporate movement sensors that lie beneath baby's mattress and set off an alarm if they detect no movement.

If you're an anxious parent who constantly watches the rise and fall of your baby's chest whilst they sleep, a movement monitor might help you to get some proper rest. For other parents, it could create more anxiety than it alleviates. A false alarm can be very, well, alarming. With these, you can be anywhere in the world and tune in to see your baby sleeping; or send a link to faraway relatives so that they can witness the bedtime routine. In searching for the best baby monitors for this article, I've focussed on testing and reviewing nonconnected audio and video monitors, which only broadcast to a parent unit within an immediate radius using various frequencies. Think of them as walkie talkies rather than superconnected smartphones. I could gently ask for a drink while

breastfeeding without shouting down the stairs. Parents of toddlers told me that they found talkback useful to instruct a naughty tot to get back in their cot if they're trying to climb out. Most monitors require charging for hours before first use. The baby units generally require constant mains power so you'll need to position them near a power socket in baby's room. Some monitors come with wall mounts, but most are designed to stand on a flat surface. Always ensure that you keep cables and wires well out of baby's reach. If you buy a monitor, always remember when its switched on that you can be heard in baby's room. You don't want to be those parents who carp about your guests whilst putting your baby to bed and then rejoin the party to find a room full of hurt and offended guests who've listened to every word of your private conversation broadcast over the monitor. Ouch. It has excellent sound quality and sensitivity, meaning that with the volume turned up, I could hear every noise my baby made. Whenever there is a sound, a subtle green light glows at the top of the monitor. If the crying is particularly loud then the green light turns red.

It's completely intuitive to use, with clearly marked buttons on the front, making it friendly for babysitters and other family members at first glance. It also has a pretty impressive battery life, easily lasting for a day of naps and a long evening without its charger. There's also a temperature display. The baby unit can project a light show which is sweet, illuminating various spots on the ceiling with clusters of stars, sheep, and rockets. It's not flashy or bright, but dim enough to be restful for tired eyes. You can also play a range of quality audio sounds, including a selection of classical pieces of music, instrumental nursery rhymes, forms of white noise including hair dryer, vacuum cleaner or womb effect and sounds from nature including bird song, whale song, and waves. You can select what you want to play using the menu on the parent unit and stop it remotely too. It never lost its connection during my testing unlike many pricier models and I used it throughout my house and garden for weeks. However I wouldn't recommend relying on this monitor in mute mode if you want to be alerted to every noise your baby makes. When you mute the parent unit it has five lights in a horizontal line which are designed to alert you to any sounds in your baby's room. Unfortunately I didn't find these lights to be as sensitive or reliable as other monitors on the mute mode. Whilst the lights always came on when my baby cried, sometimes they didn't light up when I could hear my baby making noises; whereas when the volume was up, I found this monitor conveyed every sound. The battery life is average and lasts an evening away from the charger. If this monitor doesn't detect any movement in the cot for 15 seconds including breathing it will set off a rouse alarm which should prompt any still baby in a deep sleep to wriggle. If no movement is detected after a further five seconds, an alarm sounds on both units.

As an audio monitor, it has excellent sound quality, transmits using DECT technology which is considered more secure, a good range working throughout my house and garden, and it never lost its connection during my testing. There is a small digital horizontal bar on the display screen which fills up with white blocks to indicate noise, but it's arguably too subtle. The battery life on the parent unit is impressively longlasting and can go many hours, easily covering day naps and a long evening away from its charger. It needs to be laid upon a hard surface, so if your baby's cot doesn't have a solid base, then you'll need to source a piece of hardboard measuring at least 33cm squared. Fortunately I found some scrap plywood in our shed to do the job and cover the slats on our cot, but it was an extra hassle at the start. You simply press into all the corners of the mattress to ensure that it's registering movement everywhere and won't set off the alarm if the baby is at the edges of the cot and then you're good to go. You have to remember to pause the movement monitor every time you take baby out of its cot, otherwise you'll set off the alarm. When stumbling out of bed at night towards my crying baby, it was another step to press the pause button before picking up and comforting my baby. Most irritatingly, when the movement monitor is paused, the baby unit bleeps



every 20 seconds to remind you that you're on pause. As I paused the monitor whilst feeding my baby in bed at night, the bleeps were a rather irritating soundtrack to a long feed. I didn't find a way to silence these bleeps without switching off the whole unit. When the parent unit is muted its lights clearly flash whenever your baby makes a noise and the lights appeared sensitive to every sound during my testing. It has five blue lights in a vertical line which indicate an escalating scale, with all of them lighting up when the baby is loud.

It sounded an alarm to alert me to this loss and flashed a red light to show that the link was broken. I switched the parent unit off and on again and it immediately reestablished connection, but I didn't find it as reliable as those that appear above on this list. There is no menu to navigate. You can easily switch it on and off, adjust the volume and sound sensitivity and press a Talk button to activate talkback. It doesn't have a temperature display. It has an impressive battery life and comes with a neck strap, should you wish to wear it around the house or garden. The baby unit can play five lullabies which might be nice at bedtime, but you can't order these to play or stop from the parent unit. When muted, its lights clearly flash whenever baby makes a noise. It has five blue lights in a horizontal line to show an escalating scale, which all light up when baby is loud and the far right one turns red when baby screams. It has a decent battery life and a clip on the back so you can attach it to yourself whilst on the move. It worked throughout my house and garden but randomly dropped out of range for short spells when sitting still in the rooms directly below my sleeping baby. It repeatedly lost connection and beeped to alert me. This happened in nearly every room of my house and became an intense irritation. Consumer reviews on Amazon indicate that this is a common complaint, with reports that the units delink regularly and have a poor range. The picture quality isn't fantastic. It's low resolution, so a bit blurry, but good enough to see what your baby is doing and gives a pretty clear view even in low light. The sound quality is excellent and sensitive to the smallest noises. Like BT's audio monitor, it's easy and intuitive to use with all the buttons clearly labelled on the front, apart from how to move the camera, which isn't instantly obvious.

You have to press OK and then the crosshairs appear on the screen and you can use the arrows to direct the camera position. However, you can opt to watch your baby continuously, though this rapidly drains the battery on the parent unit. Unfortunately the camera is static so can't be zoomed, tilted or panned. It can be set to show you the picture whenever there is a noise in baby's room, or you can opt to watch your baby continuously. It has an impressive battery life in comparison to the other video monitors I tested. It doesn't have a temperature sensor. It comes with a wall mount so you can easily fix the camera to a wall near baby's cot instead of standing it on a nearby surface. However it's pretty pricey for the privilege, particularly when you can't tilt or pan the camera. You can easily pan the camera up and down and from side to side and the picture quality is good, displayed on a nicely sized 3.5 inch screen. In daytime, I could see my baby's expressions perfectly. Plus, you can zoom in. The sound is crystal clear, allowing me to hear every groan and whimper. The box says that it plays five lullabies, which is a questionable definition of the noises available. The sound quality from the baby unit isn't great so the noises also sound a little fuzzy. It also has a temperature display and you can set a timer for hourlong intervals, starting from two hours. It always beeped to alert me to this loss and regained connection without me needing to switch off the machine but it seemed more temperamental than the monitors I've reviewed above. It's really simple to use with clearly marked buttons and a menu which is easy to navigate. The camera pans up and down and from side to side and allows you to zoom in. It also comes with an optional wideangle lens which easily clips on to the front of the camera. It comes with a wall mount that you can use to fix the camera to a wall, or you can rest it on a nearby surface.

It can play five gentle instrumental melodies and a range of soothing sounds, including white noise, crickets and a stream. It also has talkback, though the quality can be a little crackly. It comes with a wallmount, should you want to fix the camera to a wall rather than rest it on a tabletop. The picture

quality is pretty good and nice to watch on the parent unit's large 4.3 inch screen. It's grainy in lowlight but you can still see your baby's movements. The sound quality is excellent and came on whenever my baby made a noise. It was impressively sensitive without any background hum. I also found the sound sensitive lights on top of the monitor accurate, though they're pretty subtle so unlikely to grab your attention if you've muted the monitor. That might be a welcome feature, depending on your point of view. There's no option to continuously watch your baby; the screen only stays on for one minute before shutting off again. Most commands have to be accessed via a touchscreen menu. Whilst this may sound slick, I found using the touchscreen more cumbersome and timeconsuming because you need to press the screen to bring the menu up and press firmly on each icon to successfully navigate around. It has talkback and a temperature display. You can pause or switch off the movement sensor from the parent unit using the touchscreen menu. As a video monitor it works well. The sound quality is excellent and conveyed every noise my baby made. The picture quality is also good, displayed on a small 3inch colour screen. You can't pan or tilt the camera, but you can zoom in for a closer look. It tells you the temperature in the room and you can page the parent unit to find it if you misplace it. The screen is designed to come on for a few seconds whenever your baby makes a noise, or if you press the screen button to check on your baby. The camera didn't always automatically come on when my baby made a noise. I'd hear my baby coughing but the screen would stay black.

That said, whenever my baby cried loudly during testing, the screen came on. You can continuously watch the screen if it's plugged into the mains. However, there is a vibration option where the parent unit will vibrate to alert you to any noise. However, unlike Angelcare's wireless movement sensors, this movement pad has a wire which connects to the baby monitor. So as well as plugging the baby monitor into the mains, you have to plug the movement pad into the baby monitor. I hurriedly unplugged the monitor, anxious to stop the alarm before it woke my baby. Because I couldn't see in the dark which cable was the movement sensor and which was the power input, I unplugged both in a panic. The following day I changed the sensitivity settings, but within ten minutes of my baby napping the alarm sounded again so I switched off the movement sensor for good. Its one selling point is the fact that both units have around ten hours of life from one charge, making it a potentially useful travel monitor if you're staying somewhere without sockets. But that's all I have to commend it. You can't move or pan the camera, but you can zoom in. It has talk back, a temperature display and a clip on the parent unit. The menu is awkward and painstaking to navigate. It feels cheap and tacky and lost signal a few times during my testing. It comes on if your baby makes a noise but switches off after five seconds of silence. You can press a button to view your baby but you'll only get a fleeting look. I found this particularly annoying when my baby cried out and the picture flashed on and barely gave me time to see their expression before going black again.
