For color transmission or color copying, press this button to turn on its light. Also selects the image quality setting resolution and paper type for the document you are copying. To use the onetouch speed dialing buttons, the Function button's light must be off. To access the special functions, press Function to turn on its light and then press the button you wish to access. To use the special function buttons, press this button to turn on its light. To use the onetouch speed dialing buttons, press to turn off its light. Remove them immediately when they run out of ink, and replace them with new BJ tanks. Do not leave a cartridge with one of its ink tanks missing as the ink in the cartridge will dry and adversely affect print quality.
