When the T-800 arrives to kill her in 1984, she is confronted almost immediately by the Guardian and deactivated by Sarah with a .50 caliber bullet to her battery. Although it was subsequently reactivated by the T-1000, it is again deactivated by Kyle Reese who blows his head off. The T-800 is dissolved in acid and its CPU is used as the raw version of the Time Displacement Equipment operating system, at which point it is burned and probably destroyed by the Guardian. As a result of the total destruction of the T-800, Cyberdyne does not get its CPU for the studio, Skynet is not created and Judgment Day does not occur in 1997 and is postponed to 2017, which Kyle learns from memories of the new timeline received during time travel. In this new timeline, after being converted to a T-3000 by Alex, John Connor is pushed back to 2014 where he helps Cyberdyne build Genisys, an operating system that, once activated, will control and connect all the world’s hardware, including military hardware. Genisys is Skynet in a new form and once it will be online, Judgment Day will begin. Kyle, Sarah, and Guardian are working to stop it and destroy Genisys before it’s fully online. They are hampered in their efforts by John, but still attack Cyberdyne, causing John to speed up Genisys activation from 13 hours to 15 minutes. Despite John’s best efforts, the three destroy the facility and, apparently, Skynet. Judgment Day is avoided, but without their knowledge, the core of Skynet’s system survives underground and becomes self-aware. It is likely that Judgment Day has just been postponed to another time as a result. Terminator Genisys 2020[] In the world of Jade, Skynet became self-aware in 2021. In the timeline of the dark destiny, after the closure of Skynet and the destruction of a Cyberdyne building, a new timeline was created, in which the Day of Judgment took place in 2020. In this timeline, another Artificial, the Legion, was responsible for the new Judgment Day, which began by cutting humanity off from needed services and electronics.
