This tutorial will show you how to map onedrive as a network drive folder in your Windows 10 PC and assign it a Letter of drive as we go. You will be able to look for all your files on your OneDrive without the need for SmartFiles or placeholders, which have now been in Windows 10. Why would you like to do this? If you want to be able to easily navigate to your files in Explorer without having them on your local computer, then this is a reason. You can search for files that are "online only" with this method. If you want to keep your files in OneDrive, but not on your local machine, but have apps or programs that need a local drive path to work with them, then this solution is for You. How to realize it. 1. Using your favorite web browser, you will go to OneDrive.com and make the login in your OneDrive account. 2. Open any folder in your OneDrive account. 3. Now, take a look at the address bar. The URL here is very important. Something like: [Box = URL] [/ box] What you want is the part "cid = 1234567890Abcdef". Copy only the numbers / letters after "cid =", which in this example would be "1234567890ABCDEF". 4. Open Windows Explorer. Select the drive letter you want to use for OneDrive. 6. Now in the "folder" text box, type " followed by the cid number that you recovered in step 3. Example: [Box = folder] https: // D . docs.live.net/1234567890abcdef[/box] 7. If you want the drive to be available every time you enter Windows 10, select "Reconnect to Login." 8. Check "Connect using different credentials" so you can confirm your OneDrive login information. If your login name is populated and it starts with "Microsoft account", be sure to remove that part. Only your email to the OneDrive login should be in this box. It will have time to connect the first time, and you will eventually be prompted to enter your login to OneDrive. After entering your credentials, it will take time to your computer to connect completely. It will connect more fast in the next time you enter your computer, but you can slowle the files begin to show on my pc, but my new drive card is available in Windows Explorer with all files and folders from my OneDrive. Any application or program that can read files on your local PC now can access your OneDrive files.
